Pest Services

Ants

Ants are readily adaptable and can nest in a wide range of locations. Colonies can be large and may contain hundreds of reproductive Queens. Ants can contaminate food products and spread disease.



Beetles

Beetles fly readily and are attracted to light. Larvae are often attracted to soiled fabrics and cracks and crevices where lint, food crumbs or dead insects accumulate. They can damage carpets and clothing.

Cockroaches

Cockroaches may be found wherever food is stored or prepared, can contaminate food products, spread disease, and aggravate allergies.

Earwigs

Earwigs are active at night, hiding in cool, damp ground cover during the day. They service on dead plant and animal material. Found primarily outdoors, they are known to move indoors and into crawl spaces.

Fleas

Fleas and their eggs are typically found on pets, near pet areas and in carpet. Once established, fleas can reproduce rapidly into large numbers. Fleas can spread disease and cause irritating bites.



Mice

Mice are not only a nuisance, they may damage homes and destroy belongings by gnawing. They eat stored foods causing contamination and transmitting diseases. One pair of mice can produce 200 offsprings in 4 months.

Moths

Moths are commonly found in homes. The female Indian Meal Moth will lay between 100-400 eggs on food materials in her life span. The larvae will feed on pantry products, rendering these products unsanitary.



These rodents can nest within a structure at any time. Rats will damage homes and destroy belongings by gnawing. They eat stored foods causing contamination and transmitting diseases. Rats have been known to bite humans.

Spiders

Some spiders prefer to hide in cracks, dark areas or webs. Others prefer dry areas like heater vents, upper corners of rooms and attics. Some spiders may bite if disturbed. The Black Widow and Violin species are common in California and are poisonous.

Wasps

Wasps are about 1/2" – 1" in length. They are scavengers and predators which feed on a wide variety of insects. These insects are often a nuisance during warmer months, and can inflict painful multiple stings when disturbed. It's important to exercise caution when coming across insects that fly and sting. Encounters can result in pain and severe allergic reactions.
